

Occasionally American Time will have new firmware updates available. Contact American Time for the most recent firmware version available. Firmware updates require access to the internet through port 80.

■ **Note:** If traffic is redirected on port 80, firmware updates will fail. Prior to completing the firmware update process verify internet access is available on port 80.


To complete a firmware update, complete the following process:

1. Apply power to Wi-Fi module by inserting the barrel plug from the power source into the left side of the Wi-Fi module where the power connection is located. If clock is currently running, go to step 3.





- 2. Verify the LED starts flashing.
- 3. Wait for the LED to either stop flashing (Battery clock) or turn a solid color (Electric clock).
- 4. Press and hold the button located on the middle of the Wi-Fi module.



- a. The LED should turn solid green to indicate the button press (continue holding the button).
- b. Wait for the LED to flash orange one time quickly (do not release the button).
- c. Wait for the LED to flash orange twice quickly (do not release the button).
- d. Wait for the LED to flash orange three times quickly.
- 5. Release the button.
 - a. Verify the LED alternates green/orange/red.
 - b. Verify LED turns off.
 - c. Verify LED flashes red.
 - Note: If the LED turns solid red for approximately 3 seconds, the firmware update process failed.

 To verify firmware update process is successful connect to the clock in <u>configuration mode</u> and verify firmware version at the bottom of the browser page. Contact American Time technical support at 800-328-8996.
- 6. Power cycle Wi-Fi module by disconnecting barrel plug from the power source for 5 seconds and reconnecting.
